#### BACHELOR OF ARTS (GENERAL)

The B. A. program runs in six semesters spread over three years. In each of the first four semesters (i.e., two years), a student shall read one compulsory paper and three electives of their choice per semester. The electives will remain constant across four semesters. In the final year (the fifth and the sixth semesters), a student shall choose *any one* of the three electives as his/her Major. Saint Claret College offers seven electives (listed below). An applicant must choose *any three* of the following electives (with an exception: you cannot choose both Anthropology and Geography). See the Prospectus for a brief on each elective. It is the responsibility of the candidate to be informed of what each discipline is about. **Once the admission is completed, no change of Combination will be permitted under any circumstance.**

<sup>1</sup>Security Deposit is refundable only at the end of the year/semester, after deduction for disciplinary sanctions, if any.

<sup>2</sup>First year applicants from Lod, Kalung, & Panyu Ayo clans are eligible for 50% concession on Development Fee as gratitude discount to donor clans. This discount policy is not a permanent feature, but will be in force until the year 2020 (as part of SCCZ Vision 2020) or until amended, whichever is earlier.

<sup>3</sup>The University Fee to be paid here is for registration/continuation only. For University examinations, separate fees are to be paid, at the time designated for applying for examinations only.

### REFUND POLICY

If a student, after completing the admission process at SCCZ, wishes to cancel the admission, the following refund policy shall apply: *Only course fee, and semester fee, are refundable, on production of original receipts. No refund request will be admitted after classes begin.*

### ADD-ON CERTIFICATE COURSES (See details in the Prospectus)

- **Diploma in Computer Applications (DCA):** Given the necessity of computer education for employability, DCA is mandatory for all first year students. A student may be exempted on production of documentary evidence on having completed a previous course in computers (of at least 3 months' duration.) No. of Seats = 200; Fees = **Rs. 3,000/-** (single installment)
- **Other Certificate Courses:** See Prospectus for a listing of other certificate courses. They are mandatory for all First Semester students. Each student must select one Certificate course compulsorily. Classes will be conducted during Semester I and Certificates will be awarded after assessment.  
**Certificate Course Fee:** To be paid during the Admission. **Rs. 300/-** (Personality Development, Communicative English, Tourism Management) **Rs. 500/-** (Short Film Production)

### HOSTEL ADMISSIONS

The filled-in applications together with the required documents must be submitted along with the College Application Form. Selected candidates will be notified along with the Admission Merit List, and shall take admission to both College and Hostel on the day specified on the Admission Merit List, failing which the seat may be offered to the next eligible candidate.
