BANT 612: Fieldwork/Practical and Report Writing

Total Marks: 100 (20- CIA, 20- Presentation, 20- Viva Voce, and 40- Report Writing)

Objectives: Having undertaken the fieldwork/practical, a student will be able to:

- a. Familiarize with different conventional/essential field research methods and techniques to conduct field survey micro-research*
- b. Conduct various anthropometric measurements/studies using different instruments and techniques as adopted in biological anthropology.*

14 days fieldwork will be carried out by the students within India/ Northeast India/ Arunachal Pradesh. Students will be accompanied by the teachers. The purpose of the fieldwork is to teach students how to conduct field survey by using different conventional research methods and other essential field techniques. This will be done on the basis of micro studies. On the completion of fieldwork, every student must prepare a field report under the supervision of teachers who guides the fieldwork. Report has to be submitted one month prior to commencement of RGU End Semester Examination.

Practical classes on various anthropometric measurements/studies using different instruments and techniques as adopted in biological anthropology may be conducted for students during his/her course of study. Report of the same has to be submitted one month prior to commencement of RGU End Semester Examination.
