



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING is entered into by National Institute of Social Communications Research and Training (NISCORT) on the one part, hereinafter called "NISCORT", represented by its Director, Rev. Dr. Jose Murickan, and on the other part, represented by the Saint Claret College, Ziro, Arunachal Pradesh, represented by its Principal, Dr. Fr. Allwyn Mendoz CMF, at the expiry of the first MoU dated the First day of June, 2014 with a validity of three years.

WHEREAS NISCORT established by the Catholic Bishops' Conference of India (CBCI) as a national institute to impart university level and short-term courses in communication and media studies, to promote research and education and to seek collaboration with various universities and academic institutions related to communication in India and abroad.

WHEREAS NISCORT has been rendering these services through offering Undergraduate and Post Graduate Degree courses, Diploma and Certificate Courses in Communication under the aegis of the CBCI Society for Social Communications Research and Training, a registered society under Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860, No S. 31861 of 1996.

WHEREAS NISCORT intends to provide educational content and support services to institutions with similar interests and seeking to collaborate in attaining the goals for which it has been established through offering offline, as well as online programmes.

And, WHEREAS NISCORT is particularly committed to the formation of youth and nourishes their growth to make them useful and productive members of society.

WHEREAS Saint Claret College is established by the Claretian Formation Association of North East India with the aim of imparting training and formation at university level to Youth with special focus on the empowerment of youth belonging to the various tribes of the state of Arunachal Pradesh.

AND WHEREAS Saint Claret College is part of or sharing in the vision of this institution in India mainly focused towards catering to the needs of the youth especially their educational needs.

AND WHEREAS Saint Claret College has come forward with an interest to associate with NISCORT through campus outreach programmes, in house hands-on training programmes, exposure study visits, practical sessions, contact classes, library facilities, regular teaching programmes, etc.

Whereas Saint Claret College shall undertake to see that the students and staff participating in programmes agree to abide by the course modalities, content, rules, and guidelines that would be drawn up after mutual discussion and understanding.

AND WHEREAS NISCORT shall undertake to provide the necessary infrastructural facilities and appoint faculty to organize the contact programme, and Saint Claret College shall ensure the participants, their good conduct, compliance with guidelines, payment of fees and other remunerative charges, etc. to ensure that efficient and effective conduct of the programme and learning take place.

AND WHEREAS Saint Claret College hereby agrees to undertake the responsibility of effectively coordinating with NISCORT for the smooth conduct of such programmes.

AND WHEREAS Saint Claret College hereby agrees to abide by the guidelines framed by NISCORT and mutually agreed and updated from time to time in all matters relating to this collaboration.

AND WHEREAS the MOU signed herewith is valid for the duration of five years only. The same shall be renewed after this period on the basis of a review of the performance and practices to the mutual satisfaction of both the parties.

AND WHEREAS both NISCORT and Saint Claret College reserve the right to discontinue future Programmes due to conditions beyond their control such as, but not limited to, war, strikes, fires, floods, acts of God, governmental restrictions, legal actions of any manner whatsoever, damage or destruction of any network facilities or servers or software glitches. Such an action shall not be deemed to be a breach of this MOU.

AND WHEREAS any dispute arising with regard to any aspect of this MOU shall be settled through mutual consultation and by written consent by the parties to the MOU. In case settlement is not arrived at, the dispute will come under the purview and provisions of Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 of Government of India and the area of exclusive jurisdiction will be New Delhi.

AND WHEREAS this MOU shall continue during any dispute proceedings or any other dispute resolution mechanism.

AND WHEREAS the Delhi based courts will have exclusive jurisdiction to adjudicate any dispute arising under or in connection with this MOU not settled through arbitration.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have affixed their seal and signature to this Memorandum of Understanding on this First Day of June, 2017 at NISCORT, A-2 Vaishali, Ghaziabad Dt. 201 012 NCR Delhi.
