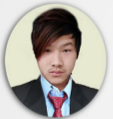

Staff Orientation Program

The College kept up the practice of conducting certificate courses for its students. With the involvement of the different departments of the College, PESEC (People Education and Social Empowerment Centre) organized the certificate courses during the first half of the academic session. Personality Development, Tourism Management, Communicative English, Banking Exams and Short Film Production were the different certificate courses completed. The Diploma in Computer Application course however remained incomplete due to the Lock down on account of the pandemic. This course will be completed as and when normalcy is restored.

The Coaching Centre for UPSC and Competitive Exams housed at the college had a small and enthusiastic group of aspirants for civil services. The SCCZ-ALS IAS Coaching Centre had an enrolment of 20 aspirants in the General Studies Extensive Batch, and 15 aspirants in the Foundation Batch. Yet again due to the pandemic, there was a temporary disruption of classes, which resumed after a while in the online mode.

IIRS Certificate Courses. The College is proud to have been included as a Nodal Centre for Distance Learning Program of ISRO IIRS from 2019. The SCCZ Nodal Centre has facilitated the conduct of 06 courses. A total of 75 participants enrolled for the courses and received certification on completion. The IIRS Nodal Centre envisions to be instrumental in facilitating the spread of knowledge about Remote Sensing and GIS (Geographic Information System) through the distance learning mode.

Journal Interviews

The international peer reviewed inter-disciplinary journal in Social Sciences, InterViews, was published for the sixth time in as many years from the College. The Volume 6 of Interviews was a special edition which included all the policies and guidelines of the Journal. The Journal now has its own website (www.interviewsjournal.com). The articles carried in InterViews have been allotted DOI (Digital Object Identifier), a system which will give a unique identification for each of the articles published in the Journal. The latest updates to the journal through the Website and DOI, have certainly raised its standard.

Campus Festivals

Resonance '19: Resonance '19 was conducted with a lot of fan-fare. The weeklong Art, Literary, Cultural, Sports and Games Competition of the College was held from 16-25 October, 2019. The event saw the enthusiastic participation of a large number of students. The theme for Resonance '19 was Environmental Protection. The teams were named in a manner that gave them special identity as custodians of the various elements of the Environment. The entire event was marked with excellent performances and sportsmanship. The one day event was organized in collaboration with the District Legal Services Authority. The Key Note Address was delivered by Hon’ble Justice, N. Kotiswar Singh, Executive Chairman of the Assam State Legal Services Authority and Central Authority member of National Legal Services Authority. A host of other dignitaries from the State Legal Services Authority of Assam and Arunachal Pradesh, attended the event. The Students and Staff of the College benefited a great deal from the sessions and interaction with the resource persons.

National Workshop on Digital Libraries: SCCZ in collaboration with Indian Statistical Institute (ISI), Bangalore organised a three-day National Workshop on Open Source Software for Digital Libraries and Library Automation from 25 to 27 February, 2020.

Resource persons Prof Devika Madalli, Head, DRTC, Indian Statistical Institute, Bangalore, Prof (Rtd) A R D Prasad, DRTC, Indian Statistical Institute, Bangalore, and Dr Firstborn Sumer, NEHU, Shillong, imparted training appropriate skills, information, and experience in Digital libraries and Library Management Systems.
