Parismita Singh's books include The Hotel at the End of the World, Mara and the Clay Cows, Centrepiece: New Writing and Art from Northeast India and Peace has Come. She is working on a year long non-fiction graphic novel series for the Huffington Post and writes a column The Broken Thread, and works on a school project with the NGO Pratham.



Ranju Dodum is an Itanagar-based journalist, an irregular blogger, and a dreamer of becoming a writer who tells the stories of the land and the people of Northeast India. He is obsessed with Batman, all things comics, and Liverpool Football Club.



Shiv Ankit Ahuja lives and works in New Delhi. He was an artist-in-residence at the Terra Vivente Art Studio, Italy and at the International Art Residency in New Delhi. While the 'expanded' field of photography informs his work, Shiv has also worked as a musician for a decade.

WORKSHOPS

Art workshop
with Minam Apang and Madhavi Gore
27 September 10am – 2pm, 28 September 10am – 5pm

The workshop focuses on the designs in nature and asks how our visual and aesthetic sensibilities are sensitive to and are informed by line, movement, and texture that one finds upon observation of nature and its forms. In the two days of the workshop, you will record and log notes, maps, drawings, and make collections. You will invest in the process of creating a collaborative ephemeral artwork in-situ, as a means to arrive at a heightened aesthetic visual experience in/with nature. We will look at the elements of Time, Site, Context, as key ingredients, as material, in developing the expression and form of the work of art.

Science and Myth: An interactive climate change workshop

When we think about climate change, we think about activists telling us that the world is going to end; or we think about 'skeptics' saying that it is all a hoax and we are too small to affect the way that nature functions. But what does the science say and how do scientists make these long term projections? They are struggling with predicting the weather, so how can they confidently predict something that is much more complex and years into the future?

This workshop will take you through the science of climate change, show you how scientists can predict the future and also what these predictions say. You will get to participate in some hands on experiments that show how climate change actually functions. The future of the Earth and your more immediate surroundings will be laid bare without any myths. The questions that this workshop will help you answer are: Must we change? Can we change? Will we change? And most importantly, what can I do to help?

Ziro Zine: Learn the craft of writing and zine making

Everyone has a story, and they are all worth sharing. At the Ziro Zine workshop, students will learn how best to tell a story, and how to create a self-published zine. With the help of facilitators Shiv Ahuja (artist and photographer) and Nandini Nair (journalist and editor), students will literally get their hands dirty in the reporting and writing, editing and production of stories. Through the workshop, students will learn that writing is rewriting, the importance of feedback and reviewing, and the need to sync text with images. At the end of the workshop, the students will have created a short but compelling zine, which reflects their interests, and speaks in their voice.

ARTIST BIOS



Amanda Basaiawmoit was born into a Khasi family. She shares stories through poetry and promotes creative arts amongst the youth, and teaches English Literature in Shillong College.



Dr. Anoop Mahajan works as an atmospheric chemist at the Centre for Climate Change Research, IITM, Pune. He researches the various chemical processes that occur in the atmosphere and how these can be used to predict the future climate. He runs a series called Science on Tap, where scientists and public meet to talk about science.



Dani Sulu is currently the Secretary to the Government of Arunachal Pradesh. He handles several departments including Library, Cultural Affairs, and Transport. He is also a columnist, and his byline is often seen in The Arunachal Times.



Dibyajyoti Sarma is a writer and editor who has published three volumes of poetry and two books of translations of Assamese poets Sananta Tanti and Kamal Kumar Tanti, and an academic book. He works as a journalist and runs the independent publishing venture Red River.



Getem Apang is an artist who started the Donyi Polo School of Music in 2006. He formed the first folk fusion band in North East India, The Omak Komut Collective in 2007 and organises the first, and only, International Jazz Day event in Northeast India. He is an active member of the Arunachal Independent Musicians Forum which encourages and helps independent musicians.



Jeet Thayil has worked as a journalist for twenty-three years. His first novel, *Narcopolis*, was awarded the DSC Prize for South Asian Literature and was shortlisted for the Man Booker prize. His poetry collections include *These Errors Are Correct*, which won the Sahitya Akademi Award. As a musician, his collaborations include the noise quintet Still Dirty, the experimental trio HMT, and the opera Babur in London.



Jene Hai is a freelance artist, vice president of Arunachal Akademi of Fine Arts, and a cartoonist. He also does traditional paintings where his concepts revolve around village life, landscapes, tribal people and culture. In cartoons, he does both social and political cartoons mostly based on the present scenario of the state.



Madhavi Gore is a visual artist whose practice engages painting and performance work. She is the co-founder of HH Art Spaces, Goa. She has presented solo and collaborative performance work at international platforms. Since 2011 she has collaborated on the BODYWORKSHOP that focuses on live art.



Madhu Raghavendra is a poet and social development practitioner. He is the founder of Poetry Couture, a poetry movement that has created free spaces for poetry in India. His debut book of poems, *Make Me Some Love To Eat*, has been well received nationwide. He has conducted performance poetry workshops and readings across India.



Minam Apang is a visual artist from Arunachal Pradesh. Her work has been exhibited internationally, in particular her ink on paper and charcoal on cloth drawings inspired by folklore and storytelling. She lives in Goa and Arunachal Pradesh spending her time between her interest in art, music and developing a small art based farm in Oyan, Arunachal Pradesh.
