COMPREHENSIVE REPORT ON THE WEBINAR

The Sexual Harassment Prevention cell and Women Cell, Saint Claret College, Ziro, organized a one-day national level webinar on July 05, 2021 on the theme "Gender Sensitization-Justice" primarily targeting scholars, academicians, and students. The webinar was led by one resource personnel: Smt. Baharun Saikia, Advocate Mediator, Mediation Centre, Gauhati High Court, Guwahati. Over 121 participants participated in the program. Among the participants, 28 were from other states (Assam, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Tripura and Nagaland).

Rationale:

Gender sensitization may be seen as "the awareness informed propensity to behave in a manner which is sensitive to gender justice and gender equality issues." It is a basic requirement to understand the sensitive needs of a particular gender. It helps us to examine our attitudes and beliefs and question the „realities“ that we thought we know.

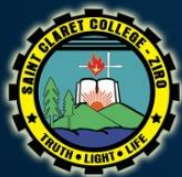

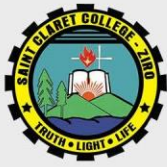
