Members absent - Fr Thomas k., Dr Vajana Thakuria, Mr. Katem Lego and Miss Junu Elapra.

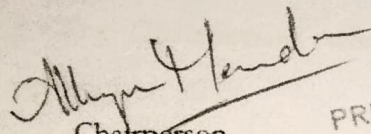
Chronicles were presented by the chronicler Dr. Jenny Jami.

Agendas discussed:

1. The house decided on complete banning of single use plastic in the campus and to use eco friendly materials. Everyone must comply to this directions
2. The principal welcomed Mr. Kago Kobing to the Dept. of Education.
3. It was informed by the chairperson not to keep pending classes till 8th Nov. and if necessary the classes can be supplemented by remedial classes.
4. Mid-Semester examination instructions were presented by the internal exam coordinator Miss Dani Yami.
5. The house decided that all the evaluated answer script must be submitted on 3rd day of its exam.
6. It was also been decided that all the evaluated papers must be submitted by 10th Oct. and the mark statements to be submitted to the IQAC.
7. The chairperson suggested all the teachers to be liberal while evaluating papers.
8. The principal also reminded the teachers not to allow the students entering in teachers cubical. Teachers can meet their students in the classroom, parlor or library.
9. Also it was strongly urged not to send the students to bring duster, pen, attendance registers etc.
10. The chairperson strongly asked all the teachers to take active participation in all the college programs.
11. He also urged the teachers not to allow their personal problems to affect their professionalism. The management would not tolerate such behavior in the college and serious action can be initiated.
12. The principal also spoke on the Drug Menace which is a serious crime that happens in and around Hapoli. He suggested the teachers to look into this matter seriously so that students are aware about it and kept away from its effects.
13. In this connection, the chairperson suggested for frisking the students bags for checking of any contraband substances.
14. The house also agreed for the formation of parents- teachers Association to present the students from drug abuse.
15. The house decided that the students will be frisked and checked onwards in the campus.
16. It was also informed by the principal that 2nd Oct. 2019 would not be a Holiday as declared by the government of India. Since Swatch Bharat Abhiyan would be conducted,
17. To celebrate this, chairperson suggested for swatch service in the campus and also asked the teachers to instruct the students on no single-use plastics.

18. Also, in any of the programme, the chair person strongly urged not to use any plastic materials by the organizers.

19. The house had a threadbare talk on the plastic materials, food provision, etc
20. A lottery draw was conducted for the selection of the dept. for Gastronomica. In which during resonance six departments will have to open a stall as part of Gastronomica. They were- Economics, History, Education, Commerce, English and Mass communication.
21. The remaining five department's i.e. political science, Anthropology and Geography, including NSS had to open a stall on CUMD day.
22. The meeting ended with closing prayer by Dr. Bok.

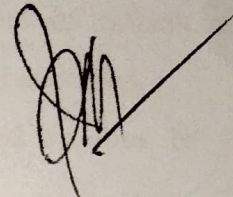
