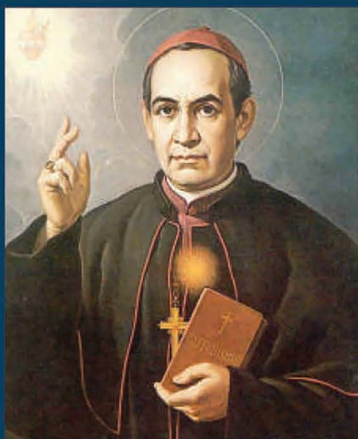

SCCZ CAMPUS

Saint Claret College, Ziro is located at a picturesque and serene 20-acre green-spread at Salaya, 3.5 kms from Old Ziro, in the Lower Subansiri District of Arunachal Pradesh, the land of dawn-lit mountains. The college has state of the art infrastructure which includes two academic blocks, library, residential halls, chapel, canteens, indoor and outdoor sports facilities, etc.

MANAGEMENT

SCCZ is established and served by the Claretian Missionaries. The Congregation was founded on July 16, 1849, by St. Anthony Mary Claret, in Spain. The Claretians are a group of catholic priests and brothers who, inspired by the love of God and in the charism of St. Anthony Mary Claret, have committed themselves to doing whatever is urgent, timely and effective for the authentic welfare of the peoples, especially those on the margins. At present, there are over 3000 Claretians working in 70 countries.

The College is permanently affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University, Itanagar, and is recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC) under sections 2(f) and 12(B) of the UGC Act. In 2024, SCCZ has received approval from the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) to start the BBA programme. The College is a member of the Claretian Consortium of Educational Institutions, Xavier Board of Higher Education in India (XBHEI), All India Association of Christian Higher Education (AIACHE), and has MoUs with other institutions.

SCCZ was accredited with Grade 'A' in 2016 (Cycle 1) by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) and has retained the Grade 'A' in Cycle 2 of its accreditation in 2024, becoming the only institution of Higher Education in Arunachal Pradesh to be accredited twice with Grade 'A' in subsequent cycles.

M.A./M.SC. GEOGRAPHY

M.A./M.Sc. Geography is a 2-year postgraduate program. In order to be eligible for this programme, the applicant must possess a bachelor's degree in geography from a recognised university. Geography is the scientific examination of the Earth and its interactions with human beings, encompassing factors such as population and resource distribution, as well as economic and political activities.

The course curriculum includes Geographical concepts, Physical Geography, Human Geography, Geographic Information Systems (GIS), Environmental Geography, Geomorphology, Economic geography, Man & Natural environment, Quantitative approaches in geography, Climatology & oceanography, and other related courses. Students acquire distinctive skills such as geospatial information systems and cartography

Curriculum Structure

- Core Courses: Generally encompass fundamental principles in geography, research methodologies, and theoretical frameworks.
- Electives: Enable students to focus on specific areas of interest, such as urban geography, biogeography, geopolitics, or geospatial analysis.
- Field Work and Project Report: Students are obligated to fulfil the requirement of either producing a thesis that is grounded in original research or completing a comprehensive field-work project. By doing this, students are able to showcase their comprehension of geographical theory and methodologies

Job prospects

Individuals who have obtained a Masters degree in Geography have the opportunity to explore a wide range of employment options including Urban and Regional Planning, evaluating land utilisation, transportation infrastructure, conducting environmental impact assessments, Environmental Management, GIS Specialist, International Development, etc.

Skills that will be acquired

Analytical thinking, research skills, communication skills, subject specific technical skills, interdisciplinary knowledge, etc.





MASTER OF ARTS (M.A.) IN POLITICAL SCIENCE

The Master of Arts (M.A.) in Political Science is a postgraduate programme specifically designed to offer in-depth knowledge and advanced research abilities in the field of political science. This programme is well-suited for individuals who want to enhance their knowledge of political systems, political behaviour, policy analysis, international and regional organizations, international relations and foreign policy. It can also serve as a preparation for further study at the doctoral level.

Key Academic Disciplines

The core curriculum generally encompasses essential aspects of political science, such as:

- Political Theory, International Relations, World Politics, Public Policy and Administration, Research Methods, Political Thought etc.

Electives: Students have the option to select electives that align with their personal interests and professional aspirations.

Project Report is a mandatory requirement for the M.A. Political Science programme. This entails undertaking independent study on a chosen subject, showcasing the capacity to apply theoretical knowledge and research abilities to practical political matters. Faculty members oversee the written dissertation, which may include an oral defence.

Job prospects

Individuals who have obtained a Master of Arts degree in Political Science have the opportunity to explore diverse professional avenues, including:

- Academic Careers, Government and Public Service, Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs), International Organisations, Private Sector

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Graduates under 10+2+3 pattern of education from Rajiv Gandhi University or any other UGC recognized University with 45% marks in Geography/ Political Science may apply for admission. The admission procedure is as given below:

- 1. Online Submission:** Application must be submitted online (www.sccz.edu.in)
All required documents and photograph must be scanned and uploaded. The requisite application fee should be paid.
There will be a helpdesk (Cont No: +91 7085320300) set up at the college to help candidates fill in their online form. (09:00 AM to 04:00 PM)
- 2. Admission will be on Merit.** All applications will go through a scrutiny after which Merit Lists will be published. Candidates selected under the Merit Lists must take admission on the allotted dates. Subsequent list(s) will be released (subject to availability of seats). Admission process includes campus culture counselling, interview, and payment of fees (see Fee Chart uploaded on the College website).
- 3.** For Admission Interview, the candidate shall be present in person along with at least one of the parents/ guardian.
- 4.** All Original documents (for verification) along with 2 additional photocopies shall be submitted on the day of Admission.
- 5.** All admissions are subject to the approval of the affiliating university (RGU)

Important documents to be submitted on the day of admission:

1. Class X Mark Sheet and Certificate
 2. Class XII Marks Sheet and Certificate (or of its equivalent exam admissible by RGU)
 3. Degree Marksheet and Certificate
 4. RGUCET/ CUET PG result/ grade sheet
 5. Transfer Certificate
 6. ST/SC Certificate
 7. Five (5) Passport size & Three (3) Stamp-size Photos
 8. Migration Certificate (only for a candidate who has graduated from a University other than RGU)
 9. Gap Certificate (only for a candidate who has had break in years after Graduation)
 10. Other Certificates (NSS, NCC, Achievement in Sports and Co and Extra-Curricular Activities)
 11. Inner Line Permit (only for non-Arunachalee)
- (Include Aadhar Card and First Page of Bank Pass Book (SBI) to be submitted only during Admission.
