Passing of Syllabi as approved by the respective Boards of Studies

The syllabus for M.A./M.Sc. Geography (Semester 2) of Rajiv Gandhi University, Itanagar has been adopted by Saint Claret College (Autonomous), Ziro at the beginning of the respective semester since the college has made a decision to follow the syllabi of the affiliating University for the academic year 2024-25. The head of the Post Graduate department presented the syllabi for Semester 2, and requested the members of the Academic Council to pass the syllabi as approved by its respective Board of Studies.
