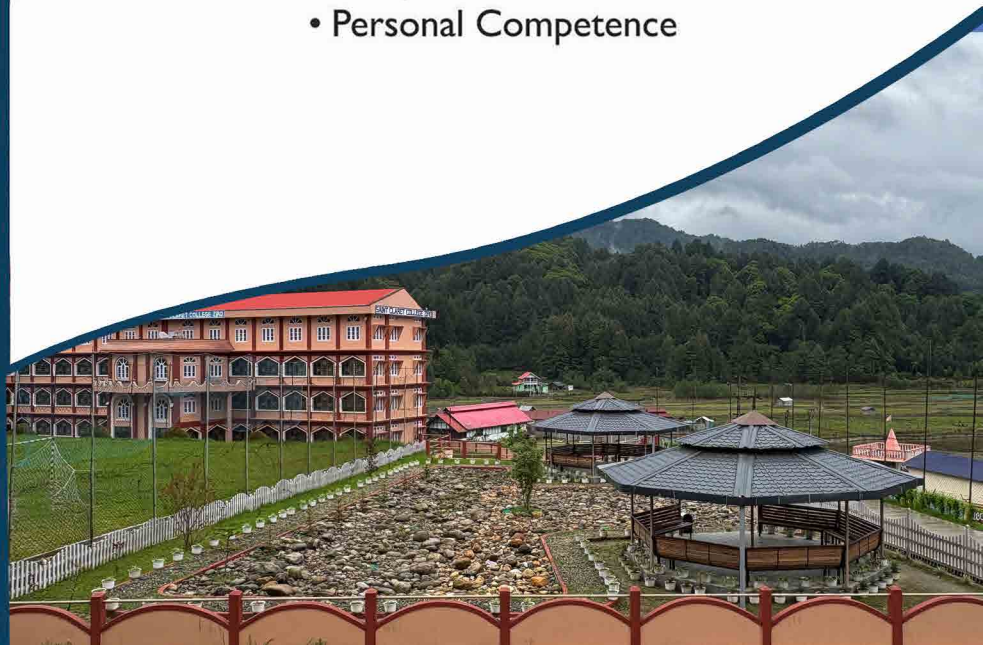

SCCZ Campus

Saint Claret College (Autonomous), Ziro is located at a picturesque and serene 20-acre green-spread at Salaya, 3.5 kms from Old Ziro, in the Lower Subansiri District of Arunachal Pradesh, the land of dawn-lit mountains. The college has state of the art infrastructure which includes two academic blocks, library, residential halls, chapel, canteens, indoor and outdoor sports facilities, etc.

Management

SCCZ is established and served by the Claretian Missionaries. The Congregation was founded on July 16, 1849, by St. Anthony Mary Claret, in Spain. The Claretians are a group of catholic priests and brothers who, inspired by the love of God and in the charism of St. Anthony Mary Claret, have committed themselves to doing whatever is urgent, timely and effective for the authentic welfare of the peoples, especially those on the margins. At present, there are over 3000 Claretians working in 65 countries.

About SCCZ

The College is permanently affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University, Itanagar, and is recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC) under sections 2(f) and 12(B) of the UGC Act. In 2024, SCCZ has received approval from the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) to start the BBA programme. The College is a member of the Claretian Consortium of Educational Institutions, Xavier Board of Higher Education in India (XBHEI), All India Association of Christian Higher Education (AIACHE), and has MoUs with other institutions.

SCCZ was accredited with Grade 'A' in 2016 (Cycle 1) by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) and has retained the Grade 'A' in Cycle 2 of its accreditation in 2024. The College has been conferred Autonomus status by UGC and RGU in 2024 making it the only college in Arunachal Pradesh to be conferred this prestigious status. As an Autonomous College, SCCZ has the freedom to design syllabi, introduce new programmes and courses, introduce innovative assessment and testing patterns, conduct examinations and announce results. The degrees are however conferred by Rajiv Gandhi University, with the name of the College on the certificate.

BACHELOR OF ARTS / SCIENCE : ANTHROPOLOGY

Anthropology is the study of human beings through time and space. In this discipline one studies how humans adapt to the changing environments and how such processes shape the evolution and variation of human populations biologically and culturally; how the social patterns and practices evolve across cultures, how the mechanism of evolution shapes human species across populations. Such knowledge is applied to solving current human problems. The programme includes practical and field work.

Economics deals with the production, distribution, and consumption of goods and services and with the theory and management of economics or economic systems. Microeconomics focuses on the action of individual humans and industries, such as the dynamics between buyers and sellers, borrowers and lenders. Macroeconomics takes a wider perspective, analyzing an entire economy (of nation or of international community) and various dynamics that impact economic processes and systems.

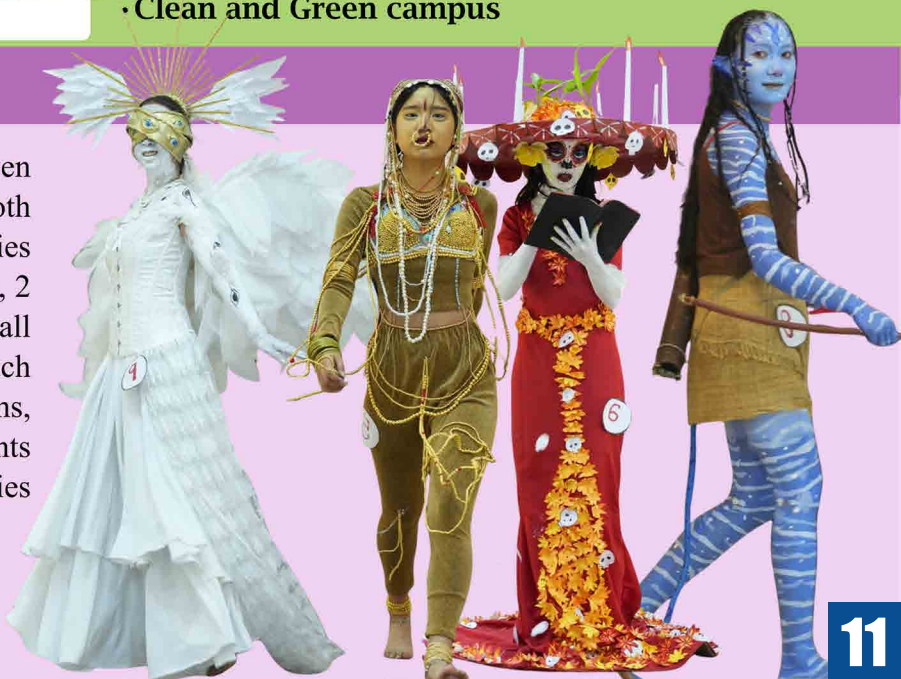

PLEASE STOP AND READ BEFORE YOU PROCEED

SCCZ strives to realize the highest ethos in education with utmost sincerity, dedication, and value-consciousness. Hence, we remain committed to the Gospel values as well as the rules and regulations of the statutory and supervisory bodies in Higher Education. Accordingly, the following rules will be strictly implemented. Only such a student who is willing to abide by these rules need to apply. She/he shall sign an undertaking to this effect, which will be absolutely binding on the student:

1. A student shall not be gainfully employed full time while being a regular student at SCCZ (Part-time employment is permitted provided the regularity of presence in class is honoured.)
2. A minimum actual attendance of 75% is absolutely necessary for eligibility for appearing in the End Semester Examinations.
3. As per the Directive from the Department of Higher & Technical Education, a student shall have at least 75% attendance for being eligible for APST Stipend, and the institution shall not accept application from any student with lower attendance (cf. Stipend Rules and Regulations 2012, IV (6)]. SCCZ will comply with this Order and any further Order in this regard.
4. The same attendance rule (75%) applies to every other scholarship/stipend instituted by the College or by any other agency through the College. A student shall be in good standing in other areas of discipline and ethos as well, for recommendation for such scholarships and other privileges.
5. A student's attendance percentage will be a permanent entry on the Transfer Certificate.
6. SCCZ has no political affiliations. No unionizing or politicking of any sort is permitted for Claretines.

What defines "a student in good standing"?

- * Minimum attendance of 75% in each semester.
- * Satisfactory performance in academic and co- & extra-curricular activities.
- * Good conduct worthy of a Claretine on and off Campus
- * Healthy and appropriate linkages and communications on social networking sites.
- * Abides by the rules and regulations of the College regulatory bodies in higher education.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Those students who have passed in Class XII/ 10+2/ Intermediate examination of CBSE/ CISCE/ any state board/ NIOS (Science Stream) or equivalent may apply for admission. The admission procedure is as given below:

1. Online Submission: Application must be submitted online (www.sccz.edu.in)
All required documents as listed below and photograph must be scanned and uploaded.
2. There will be a helpdesk set up at the college to help candidates fill in their online form.
(09:00 AM to 04:00 PM)
3. Admission will be on Merit. All applications will go through a scrutiny after which Merit Lists will be published. Candidates selected under the Merit Lists must take admission on the allotted dates. Subsequent list(s) will be released (subject to availability of seats). Admission process includes verification, interview, and payment of fees (see Fee Chart uploaded on the Online Application page of the College website).
4. Candidates without CUET will have to undergo the college entrance test.
5. For Admission Interview, the candidate shall be present in person along with at least one of the parents / guardian.
6. All Original documents (for verification) along with 2 additional photocopies shall be submitted on the day of Admission.

Important documents to be submitted on the day of admission:

1. Class X Marksheet and Certificate
